Loading Instructions

Apple II

These programs were generated using Applesoft II and a firmware card. To use them, get into Applesoft mode] and load the tape (]LOAD) . After the tape has been loaded, if you have a firmware Applesoft card you may RUN the program immediately. If not, enter the command CALL 3314 and then RUN the program. Always be certain you hear the start of the leader tone before you load the tape by hitting the RETURN key.

TRS-80 Levels I and II

Programs are stored with numbers and letters used as file names. Numbers go from 1 to 9 and letters from A to Z. You may also load the program without specifying a program file name, if you wish.

PET

PET programs are stored using file names that correspond to the specific programs being loaded. They may be loaded with or without file names.

Generally, it is best to go through each program on the tape and load it to see where the program starts on your counter. Alternatively, you can listen for the leader tone of each program and count the number of programs that you have to bypass until you get to the one you want. Tape counter readings are not given because these readings are not standard and vary drastically from one recorder to another.
